

BISA Return to Play Policy

Each team is responsible to monitor their own players and spectators to assure these protocols are followed.

All individuals 10 years of age or older must wear a face mask at all times when at any BISA soccer complex. Coaches and players may remove their masks during warm-ups and play. Any player not actively participating in the game must continue to wear their face mask. Coaches must wear a mask when entering the field of play or addressing the referee or a board member during the game. All spectators must wear their mask at all times. Referees will wear face masks unless actively working at a game.

Please maintain social distancing on sidelines and at restrooms while at BISA soccer complexes.

BISA recommends anyone at an elevated risk of infection remain home.

All players and coaches should be screened before coming to any BISA complex for practices or games. Please stay home if anyone in your family is not feeling well.

Symptoms of illness include: chills or shaking, muscle aches and pains, new loss of taste or smell, vomiting or diarrhea, sore throat, cough, fever.

Any person must not participate in BISA activities for 7 days starting with the most recent Covid-19 exposure without a positive test and no symptoms.

If you or anyone in your household has a positive test, all members of the household will fall under the positive test protocol set forth in the Return to Play Flow Chart.

All game participants are required to bring their own equipment to all practices and games including ball, water bottle, towel and hand sanitizer.

Coaches/players/spectators should arrive at the field no more than 30 minutes before game time. They should not approach a field if the previous game's participants are still at the field. All individuals should leave promptly after the end of their game to allow the next game's participants to arrive safely. No after game discussions or huddles.

Teams will line up facing each other at least 6 feet apart at the end of each game and clap for all game participants to replace hand shakes, fist bumps, player tunnels, etc.

BISA will not be supplying face masks or hand sanitizer at the fields.

BISA will follow North Texas Soccer Association's protocols for Return to Play as well as positive Covid-19 tests results follow up.
